#### Job Duties

The duties of a tow truck operator consist of communicating with a dispatcher, driving to the scene of an accident or breakdown, connecting the vehicle to the tow truck, and transporting it back to the service station or impound facility. The driver will be responsible for attaching the vehicle to the tow truck. Depending on the type of tow truck, this may include using a chain, winch, steering locks, and other devices as well as affixing lights onto the towed vehicle. A Van Lingen Towing tow truck operator will need to be able to communicate well and will need to have a basic knowledge of cars and automotive parts.. Some familiarity with automotive maintenance and repair may be required, but most of it can be learned on the job. The driver will also have to write up daily logs.

#### Job Qualifications

At the very least, candidates must have a valid driver's license and a record of safe driving to become a Van Lingen tow truck operator. You should be at least 25 years old and have a high school diploma or the equivalent. Prior work experience isn't normally required, but having experience in trucking or automotive repair is always a plus.

#### Hours

The base graveyard schedule is from 6:00 PM -- 6:00 AM, 4-5 days per week.

#### Salary / Pay / Compensation.

Van Lingen Tow truck operators start at an average of \$675 per week, depending on the amount of overtime per day. Van Lingen Towing offers paid vacation, health insurance, and uniforms for all employees.
